How does the training work? It helps prepare you to help people touched by cancer to focus more on Christ and less on cancer.

The training teaches volunteers how to share three mighty Christian tools:

- Prayer
- Scripture
- Connection

Cancer Companions has two different types of volunteers

1. **Cancer Prayer Partners** - Provide weekly contact one-on-one either by phone, email or in-person to see if there is anything new to pray for and share devotionals from our materials
2. **Cancer Bible Study Facilitators** - Lead welcoming meetings using Cancer Companions books, videos and other materials

Your loved one has cancer, now what? 2. The hands and feet of Jesus 3. Getting past fine 4. Where is God in all of this?
<p>Training is 6, one hour online training sessions</p>	<p>Training is broken into two segments. One 45 minute video session and 6 short videos totalling one hour</p>
<p>Trainees receive a training binder and a facilitator guide</p>	<p>Trainees receive a training manual that can be printed from home</p>
<p>The training includes access to a mentor who will walk you through the training process, answer any questions you may have and help you to complete the training program and take the next steps to starting your ministry. The mentor is available by email, phone or Zoom call</p>	<p>If a Cancer Prayer Partner is NOT a part of a CC team, they will have a monthly online meeting with a mentor for support</p>
<p>Cost - 3 FREE trainings with purchase of a starter kit. Additional trainings cost \$110 per person and include the 6 online training sessions, the training binder and copy of the facilitator guide</p>	<p>Cost - Free online training and a link to download the training manual to print</p>
